

The Secular Web is the most comprehensive freethought website on the Internet. Founded in 1995 by students at Texas A&M University, the Secular Web has grown to host thousands of articles and receives around 260,000 unique visitors a month. It is maintained by Internet Infidels, a nonprofit educational organization dedicated to defending and promoting metaphysical naturalism on the Internet.



Our online library has two main sections. The **Historical Library** incorporates essays on religion by historical figures such as Voltaire, Thomas Jefferson, Thomas Paine, Mark Twain, Bertrand Russell, and Albert Einstein. Rigorous peer review has been introduced for our **Modern Library**, which includes essays on arguments for and against the existence of God, the tenets of major world religions, faith and reason, science and religion, separation of church and state, mysticism, the paranormal, and even life after death. Many of the essays in the Modern Library have been written by prominent secular philosophers. We even publish rebuttals to our own pieces, allowing readers to make up their own minds as they navigate the marketplace of ideas.



The Kiosk consists of articles of general interest to secularists which are more informal than those in the Modern Library. Kiosk articles consist of particularly accessible critical essays, reviews, humor, satire, fiction, and opinions. Well-written, well-reasoned, even-handed, and tasteful articles of lasting interest from the Kiosk are typically published once a month as Featured Articles. Featured Articles may consist of popularizations of difficult concepts, nonpartisan analyses of social or other public policy issues relevant to freethought, opinion editorials, book reviews, and first-person accounts of conventions, lectures, and other events.

#### THE SECULAR OUTPOST

The Secular Outpost blog offers commentary by some of the contributors to the Secular Web on contemporary issues from a perspective that is skeptical of religious and supernatural claims. Relevant topics include, but are not limited to, arguments for the existence of God, arguments for atheism, naturalism, science and religion, evolution and creationism, philosophy, apologetics, morality and religion, and religion and politics.
